Building Works Latest

We have now been informed that the works to build two new classrooms to replace the mobile classrooms will begin in early February. The new rooms are being built alongside the 'link corridor' between Mrs Brocklehurst's and Mrs Briars' rooms. It is hoped that the works will be completed in June.

Of course there will be some disruption to the usual school routines during the works, but we are confident that disruption to class teaching will be minimal. A full risk assessment process is being undertaken and, as part of this, we will share outcomes from this with parents and children before and during the works.

In the last Parent Survey, the replacement of the mobile classrooms was identified as a key priority. This is also something that the Governing Body has been lobbying about for some time. I am sure that parents will welcome this development and agree that this is an exciting time for the school and our pupils.
