Free 'Scrapbooking' course

Warrington Family Learning Service is holding a 'Scrapbooking' course at Thomas Risley Church, starting on Monday. The course runs for ten Monday mornings, between 9.30 and 11.30am. The course offers the opportunity to 'create a lasting memento of your favourite family memories, using copies of your own photographs to put together a selection of scrapbook pages and learn how to bind your pages into an album.'
